The following is a list of clothing and gear that past visitors have found helpful. The lodge is casual so you can dress accordingly.

Take into account that for international flights the **baggage allowance** is 23 kg and for domestic flights, it is only 15 kg, as well as for taking private charter flights.

We offer **laundry services** at the Estancia, at no additional cost, so it is not necessary to bring too much luggage.

The following is a list of clothing and gear that past visitors have found helpful.

- ◇ Passport
- ◇ Copy of your flight itinerary
- ◇ Shooting gloves
- ◇ Shooting or sunglasses
- ◇ Ear protection
- ◇ Shoulder pads
- ◇ Small pliers for cutting wire tippet
- ◇ Boat shoes or sandals. Fishing is done 100% from the boat. We prefer that you have your feet covered.
- ◇ Quick-dry pants
- ◇ Shorts and lightweight shirts
- ◇ Long sleeve quick-dry shirts
- ◇ Rain Jacket (Gore-Tex recommended)
- ◇ Hats
- ◇ Personal toiletries
- ◇ Medications
- ◇ Sunscreen (50 SPF recommended)
- ◇ Chap Stick (15 SPF minimum)
- ◇ Insect repellent
- ◇ Small dry bag for the boat
- ◇ Camera, batteries, battery charger, and adaptor (Type C, 2-prong)



**The lodge is casual so you can dress accordingly.

For **duck hunting**, we do have some chest waders, knee, and hip boots, even if they are not the most comfortable, they are useful in case you do not wish to bring yours in the suitcase; otherwise, you can bring your own knee boots, and you will even use them for partridge hunting.

The lodge has **guns** for rental. We do have Benelli Montefeltro and Beretta Silver Pigeon 20 ga semi-autos, as well as some over/unders, 20, 28, and even 4.10 Ga.

As for **fishing tackle**, the lodge will also provide everything you need for the day of fishing, fishing rods, line, flies, lures, etc. The guide will be assisting you with the fishing from the boat!
